PICKLEBALL COURTS RULES



1. Use of the Pickleball court is at your own risk, you assume responsibility for your own health, safety, and belongings
2. Pickleball courts are for Pickleball use only and open to all for recreational play
3. All courts are available on a first come first serve basis, unless reserved by city-issued court permit
4. Courts may not be “held” for future use or players
5. No scooters, skateboards, bicycles, or in-line skates permitted on the courts
6. If courts are full, paddles shall be placed in the paddle holder. Placement in the holder indicates the player is next upon completion of the current game
7. In the event more than two players are waiting, the decision is defaulted to the winning player’s choice
8. No individual, group or team training and/or instruction is permitted without a permit
9. Open play is limited to one hour
10. Proper attire is required
11. No alcohol, food, gum, sunflower seeds, or glass containers are permitted
12. No amplified sounds permitted
13. Please dispose of all trash properly
14. NO TOURNAMENTS without a permit obtained through the Park and Recreation Department at 954-436-7300
15. Open play must yield to court permit holders during the times of the designated permit
16. City staff reserves the right to deny use of the Pickleball court to anyone at any time for violation of these rules, for disorderly conduct or behavior that creates a safety hazard

Pickleball Courts Rules

Be respectful, welcoming and inclusive of players of all skill levels.

1. Use of the Pickleball court is at your own risk, you assume responsibility for your own health, safety, and belongings.
2. Pickleball courts are for Pickleball use only.
3. All courts are available on a first-come, first-serve basis, unless reserved by city-issued court permit.
4. Courts may not be "held" for future use or players - ***NO GHOSTING** is ever permitted. ***GHOSTING** is when one player places an additional paddle(s) in a paddle holder to reserve a future game or court.
5. When courts are in use, paddles shall be placed in the provided paddle holders indicating the next two (sequential) players joining the general play rotation. All games are to 11pts win by 2pts.
6. When paddle holders have 4 or more paddles waiting in rotation the **FOUR ON - FOUR OFF Rule** will take effect. The **FOUR OFF Players** can go back into the general rotation. When less than 4 paddles are waiting in the paddle holders the "winners" of two (2) consecutive games **MUST** come off the court, place their paddles in the holder and wait in rotation as indicated in rule # 5.
7. Courts cannot be used for Singles games, practice, drills, warm-ups, etc. when others are waiting to play. **DOUBLES** games have priority.
8. Proper court footwear is required.
9. No scooters, skateboards, bicycles, or in-line skates are ever permitted on the courts.
10. No amplified sounds are permitted.
11. Please dispose of all trash properly in the trash receptacles provided.
12. NO TOURNAMENTS, no individual, group or team training or instructional classes are permitted without a permit obtained through the Parks and Recreation Department at 954-436-7300.
13. City staff reserves the right to deny use of the Pickleball court to anyone at any time for violation of these rules, for disorderly conduct, or behavior that creates a safety hazard.
