

RESOLUTION NO. 25-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE YEAR 50 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) AGREEMENT FOR THE SENIOR TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM BETWEEN THE CITY AND BROWARD COUNTY, ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A" AND INCORPORATED HEREIN; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE UP TO FIVE (5) ANNUAL RENEWALS TO THE AGREEMENT, SUBJECT TO THE REVIEW AND APPROVAL BY THE CITY MANAGER AND THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, staff has recommended the approval and execution of the City's Year 50 Community Development Block Grant agreement for the senior transportation; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission is desirous of adopting said recommendation and finds that doing so is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA:

Section 1: **Recitals Adopted.** That each of the above stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed. All exhibits attached hereto and incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby approves and that the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the City's Year 50 Community Development Block Grant agreement for the Senior Transportation between the City and Broward County, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof by this reference. The Mayor is hereby further authorized to execute up to five (5) annual renewals


to the Agreement, subject to the review and approval of the City Manager and the City Attorney.

Section 3. Conflicts. All resolutions inconsistent or in conflict herewith shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.


Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and adoption by the City Commission.






