

RESOLUTION NO. 25-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURSUE AND EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, AS NEEDED, FOR THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM (HMGP) WATERSHED PLANNING PROGRAM GRANT; APPROVING A LOCAL MATCH REQUIREMENT EQUAL TO TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT (25%) OF THE TOTAL PROJECT COST; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE GRANT FUNDING AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Cooper City, Florida deems it to be in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City of Cooper City to authorize the City Manager to pursue and execute a grant agreement with the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection and the Federal Emergency Management Agency, as needed, for the hazard mitigation grant program (HMGP) watershed planning program grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing “WHEREAS” clause is hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and is hereby made a specific part of this Resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Cooper City, Florida hereby to authorizes the City Manager to pursue and execute a grant agreement with the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection and the Federal Emergency Management

Agency, as needed, for the hazard mitigation grant program (HMGP) watershed planning program grant. The City Commission hereby further authorizes a local match requirement for the grant in an amount equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of the total project cost.

Section 3. The City Manager, or City Manager's designee, is hereby authorized and directed to accept the grant funds and to take any and all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

Section 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

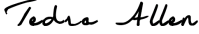
Section 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
