

RESOLUTION NO. 23-28

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, CO-DESIGNATING SW 51ST STREET IN COOPER CITY AS “AMERICAN LEGION WAY” IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 25-85(a) OF THE CITY’S CODE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 25-85(a) requires the City Commission to approve the naming of all streets in the City of Cooper City; and

WHEREAS, S.W. 51st Street in Cooper City is a City-owned road that the City Commission seeks to co-designate as “American Legion Way,” in recognition of the contributions that the American Legion Post 321 has made to the City; and

WHEREAS, the proposed street co-designation will not impact existing mailing addresses; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that co-designating SW 51st Street in Cooper City as American Legion Way is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA:

Section 1: Recitals Adopted. That each of the above stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed. All exhibits attached hereto and incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

Section 2: That the road generally known as SW 51st Street in Coper City is hereby co-designated as American Legion Way, in accordance with Section 25-85(a) of the City's Code of Ordinances.

Section 3. That the appropriate City officials are authorized and directed to take any and all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.


Section 4. Conflicts. All resolutions inconsistent or in conflict herewith shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.
